Happy New Year, and thanks for checking in.
Similar to the scoping study, we don't typically publish a formal "official" alignment document. That said, the Brandywine route reflected in the map below is the alignment we have confirmed with Mercer University as well as the District 1 Commissioner, and it remains the working alignment that will be engineered.
We'll certainly keep you in the loop if anything changes, but at this point there's nothing new planned for publication beyond what has already been shared.



Hi Mr. Wittenmyer -

It's getting close to 8 weeks since your update, so the neighborhood wanted to check on the status.

Do you have an estimated date for when Parks will release the proposed alignment?

If you don't yet have an estimated release date, could you confirm whether or not the remaining western portion of the HMC floodplain (from Hollinswood to North Fork) was indeed removed from the alignment, replacing it with the Brandywine sidepath alternative? Back in June, Commissioner Patrick had told us verbally that this had happened, but we have nothing written down that confirms it.

In your early June response you'd said that Parks had a proposed alignment and just needed a few days to confirm part of it with Mercer. Also, at a subsequent June meeting, Commissioner Patrick spoke with some neighbors and said that a decision had been made to use the Brandywine routing instead of the remaining piece of the HMC floodplain. So, the neighborhood is quite anxious to see the final written proposal.
